2. Youth (ages 19 and under) who enter 12 or more entries in the exhibit tent, will receive one (1) free pass per person to get into the Fair.

3. Entries are open to residents of the State of Virginia.

4. Use a separate entry form for each person submitting entries.

5. All entries must be the work of the undersigned.

6. Entries are to be removed from the exhibit area between 9 p.m. and 11 p.m. on Saturday, June 24, or between 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Sunday, June 25.

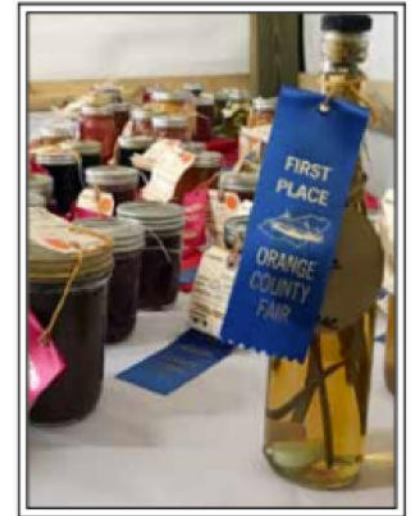
